Mamelodi Sundowns coach Rulani Mokwena has described his counterpart at TS

Galaxy, Sead Ramovic, as an attention seeker and has asked the media to give it to him.

Mokwena was responding to claims made by last Ramovic Thursday in the Nedbank Cup conference press where he claimed Sundowns the coach used the Fword during their telephonic call.


